




The latest version of Chrome no longer supports the plug-in needed for Media Shuttle, so it is recommended you use Firefox, Safari or Internet Explorer to log in.

- AnimFeat forAnimated Feature
- DocFeat for Documentary Feature
- **DocShort** for Documentary Short Subject
- LAShort for Live Action Short Film
- AnimShort for Animated Short Film
- ForFeat for Foreign Feature

When you log in you will see these options:


Click on the "Click here to add files" box and navigate to the file you wish to upload and select "Open"


Please include the following information in the Message area:

- 4) Date and time of transfer.

### **VIDEO Notes:**

- ITU-R BT.709 color space, file tagged correctly as 709
- 1920x1080 square pixel aspect ratio material (NO UPCONVERTS)
- Native frame rate of original source- 23.976/24/25/29.976
- Telecine material or 29.97 progressive content is very difficult to convert to other frame rates and is NOT preferred, will incur additional processing cost
- One second of black at head and tail of program is required

### **SUBTITLES:**

If the film is in a language other than English, English subtitles need to be burned into picture, typically in the lower third of the screen. Subs need to be properly aliased so they NEVER disappear into the video background through the entire length of the film.
